As part of the second phase of the Better Together project, SFE is developing an innovative and integrated approach aimed at improving access to quality rehabilitation services and strengthening the socio-economic inclusion of persons with disabilities in Attapeu Province. The project is based on a model that combines health system strengthening, mobile rehabilitation services, and community development to deliver accessible, sustainable, and locally rooted solutions.

Your Mission:

You will actively contribute to transforming access to rehabilitation in a rural province by strengthening local capacities and developing innovative, sustainable services, while promoting the inclusion of persons with disabilities at the heart of communities.

Your responsibilities:

- Support and build the capacity of Lao teams in rehabilitation by sharing practical, field-adapted approaches
- Contribute to the development of innovative and accessible rehabilitation services, including mobile clinics close to communities
- Train and support partners in a holistic, person-centered approach that promotes autonomy and quality of life
- Work within communities to identify, follow up, and support persons with disabilities in their care pathway
- Strengthen links between villages and health services by facilitating coordination, referrals, and continuity of care
- Build strong, trust-based relationships with local authorities and partners to ensure the long-term impact of the project

Your profile:

- State-certified occupational therapist or physiotherapist with at least 3 years of experience, ideally in disability or rehabilitation
- Ability to train, transfer knowledge, and support teams in an intercultural context
- Interest in development approaches and community-based rehabilitation (CBR)
- Autonomy, adaptability, teamwork, and motivation to integrate into a new cultural context (willingness to learn Lao)
- Good level of English (written and spoken) and alignment with SFE values
